

CUBO Awards Judging Criteria 2018

All submissions will be judged against the following criteria.

Judges will be particularly looking for submissions that showcase best in sector and innovative ways of working.

Results, finance, strategy	Submission should demonstrate that targets were set and achieved or surpassed them, this may be in the area of finance, student experience, or University Strategy.
Impact	Submission should demonstrate a measurable impact on the target audience, this may be staff, students and/or the wider community.
Innovation	Submission should demonstrate innovation or adoption of new ideas, which may include the use of new technologies.
Sustainability, environmental and wellbeing	Submission should demonstrate a wider benefit in terms of sustainability, environmental impact, or focus on student wellbeing and integration.
Team work, people and skills development	Submission should demonstrate how team or individual skills, commitment and development has contributed to success
Communication and connecting	Submission should demonstrate an increase in engagement, partnership working, communication and connecting to target audience
Feedback	Submission should evidence feedback from core stakeholders, this may include staff, students, and the wider community.

The Judges reserve the right not to shortlist or award any category where they do not feel that submitted evidence warrants award status.

Applicants who have submitted in previous years are not restricted from reapplying if they feel that their initiative remains best in sector.
